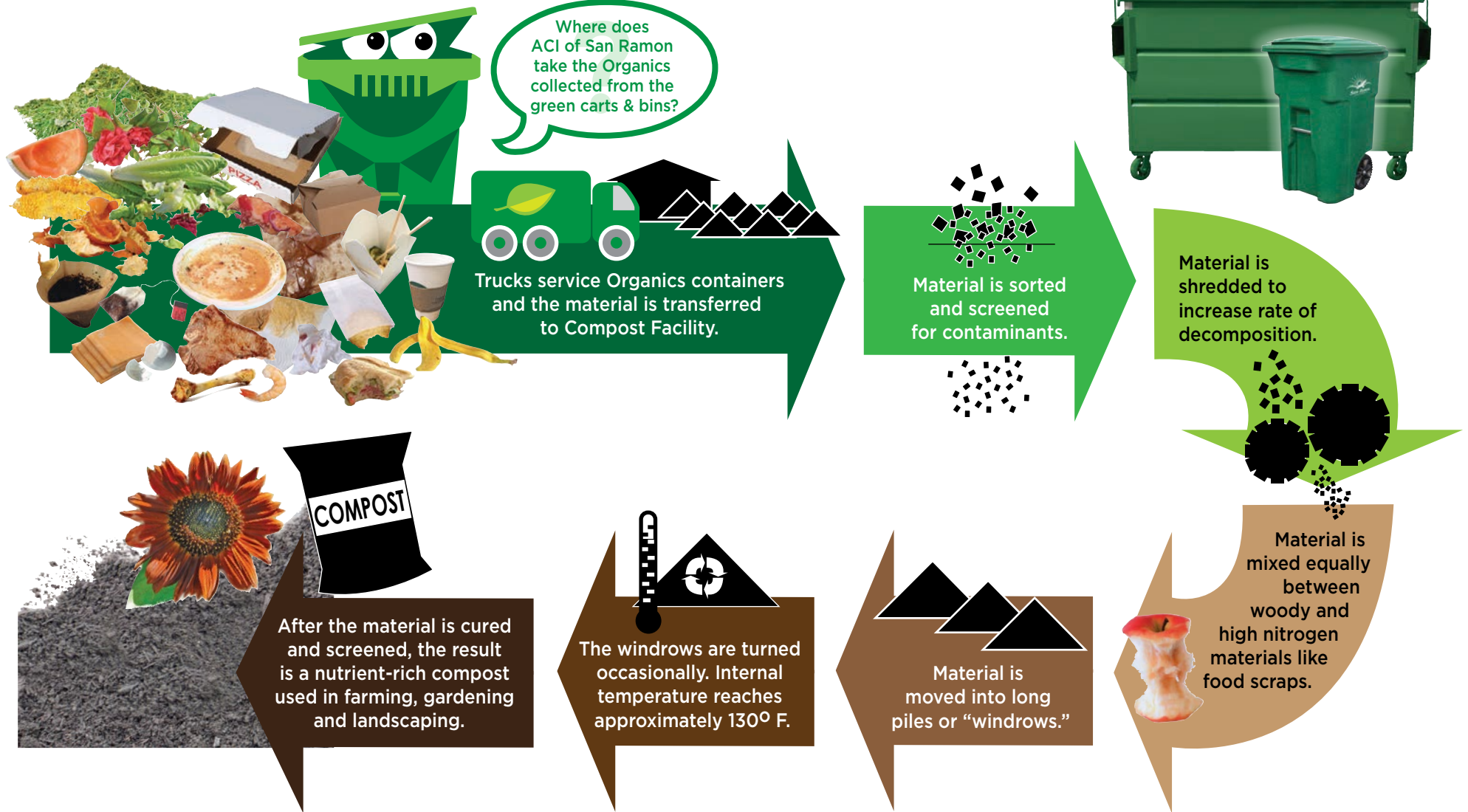


What happens to your Organics?

- In 2015, Governor Brown created the Healthy Soils Initiative for the State of California.
- Compost conserves water by increasing the water holding capacity of soil.
- Compost stabilizes soil pH and reduces soil erosion and runoff.
- By composting wasted food and other organics, methane emissions in landfills are significantly reduced.
